- **Agronomic Crop Production**

Provide educational programming to 594 producers who manage over 65,000 acres of cotton, peanuts, soybeans, corn, small grains, and pasture. Program emphasis includes: cotton production and marketing, integrated pest management, and pesticide applicator training.
