Educational Program Focus:

- 4-H Youth Development
Provide educational programming leadership for the 4-H Youth Development program in Santa Rosa County. Primary focus is on recruiting, screening, training, managing and evaluating adult and youth volunteers. Currently there are eight community clubs serving over 130 youth. Annually, we reach over 3500 school aged youth through 4-H school enrichment programs such as 4-H Tropicana Public Speaking, Embryology, Food & Nutrition, Animal Science, and Creative Arts. In addition residential summer camp programs serve over 50 school aged youth from our county. I focus on using creative delivery methods including new technology as well as traditional face to face workshops.
